

9. GENERAL RULES FOR USE

Aim the microphone toward the desired sound source (such as the talker, singer, or instrument) and away from unwanted sources.

Place the microphone as close as practical to the desired sound source.

Work close to the microphone for extra bass response.

Use only one microphone to pick up a single sound source.

Use the fewest number of microphones as practical.

Keep the distance between microphones at least three times the distance from each microphone to its source.

Place microphones as far as possible from reflective surfaces.

Add a windscreen when using the microphone outdoors.

Avoid excessive handling to minimize pickup of mechanical noise and vibration.

Do not cover any part of the microphone grille with your hand, as this will adversely affect microphone performance.

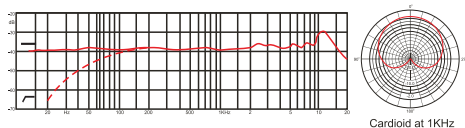

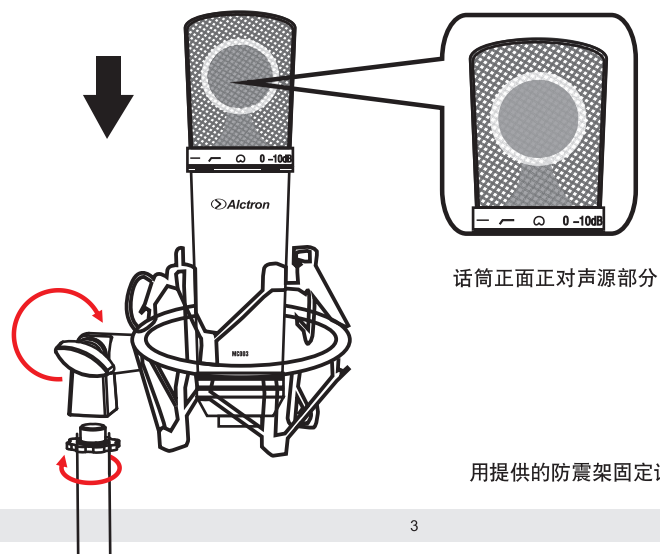
二、产品概述

MC002和MC003是一款大振膜心形指向性电容话筒，内置一个低频衰减开关，采用了32mm大振膜镀金音头和对称输出变压器设计，具有动态广，宽频响，低噪音和曲线平滑的特点。由于其具有高频清晰，低音浑厚悦耳的特点，故而被广泛应用于音乐厅，录音室以及广播电台和舞台演出等场合。

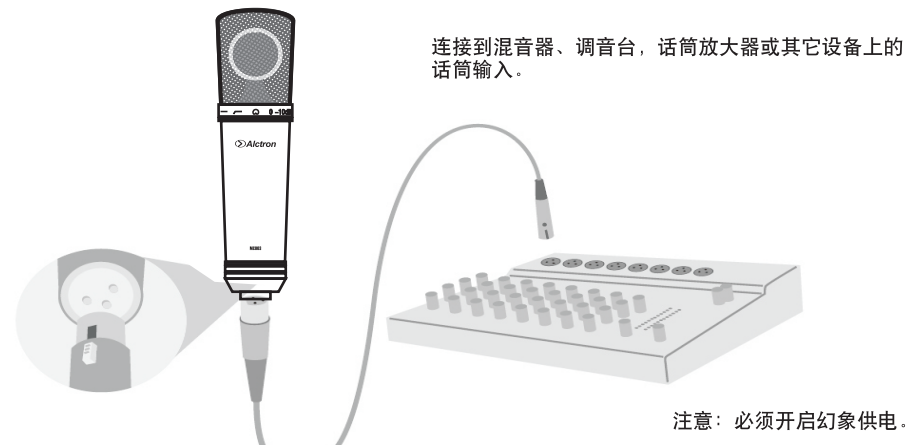
三、安装

用提供的防震架固定话筒并连接到话筒架。

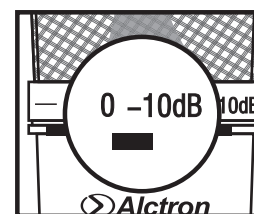
四、XLR连接



连接到混音器、调音台，话筒放大器或其它设备上的话筒输入。

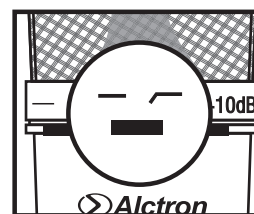

五、灵敏度(适用MC003)



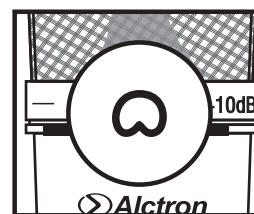
衰减开关帮助防止极高声源的失真，例如近场拾取号声或鼓声。

六、低频衰减(适用MC003)



低频滚降可用来处理人声或中音至高音范围的乐器。它可减少暖气或空调系统发出的低频室内噪声和地板震动引起的噪声。此外，还可用来补偿近讲效应，或减少使乐器声变得低沉或浑浊的低频。

七、指向性切换



MC002和MC003有1种指向性，心型指向。

八、近讲效应

当话筒与声源之间的距离在6毫米（1/4英寸）左右时，像MC310、MC320、MC330这样的指向性的话筒会将100Hz以下的低频提升6-10dB,这个现象被称之为“近讲效应”，在录音时，常会被用来创造一种更加温暖，更加厚重的音色效果。

九、一般使用规则

将话筒对准所录制的声源（例如谈话者、唱歌者或乐器），远离其他声源。

尽可能靠近所录制声源摆放。

如果想获得更多的低频响应，可将话筒进一步靠近音源。

只使用一个话筒来拾取单个声源。

尽可能减少使用话筒的数量。

保持话筒之间的距离，使其至少三倍于每个话筒与其声源之间的距离。

将话筒放置在尽可能远离反射表面的地方。

在户外使用话筒时，加一个防风罩。

避免过多触摸，以便将机械噪声的拾取和震动降低到最低水平。

切勿用手遮盖住话筒滤网的任何部位，因为这会影响话筒的性能。

应让话筒保持干燥，并避免暴露在极高温度和湿度下。

严禁向话筒音头部位吹气，请勿拍打话筒。

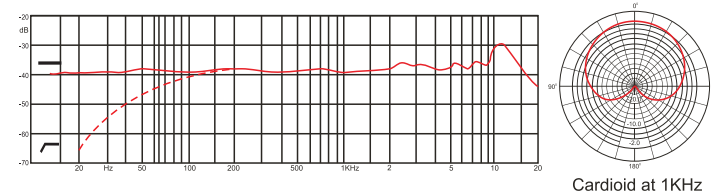

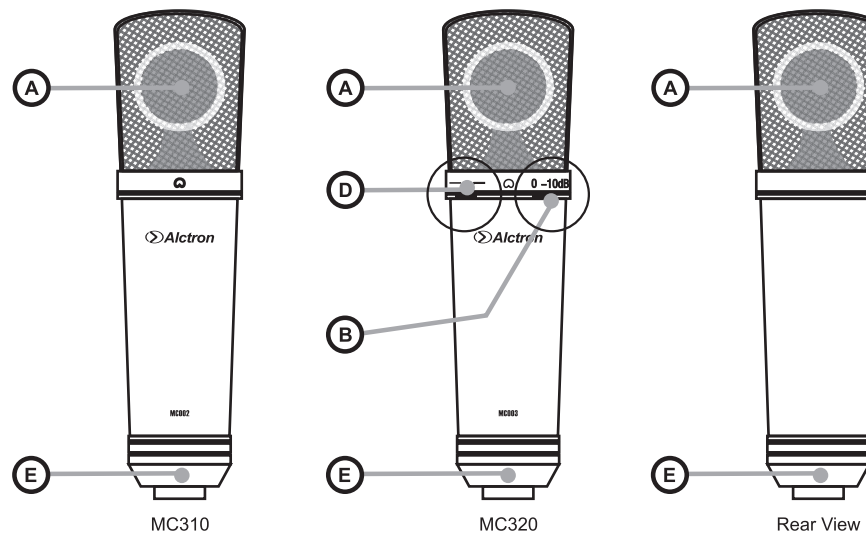

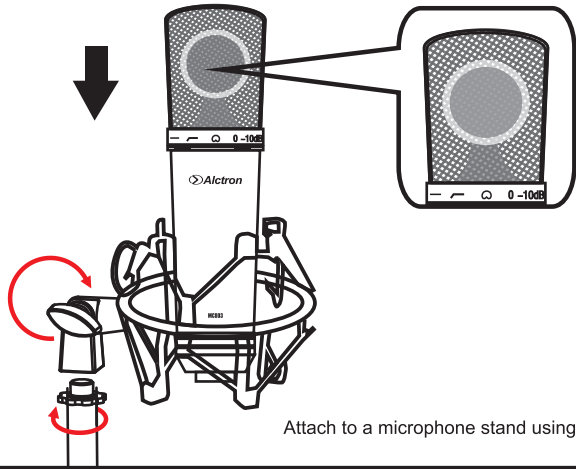
2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

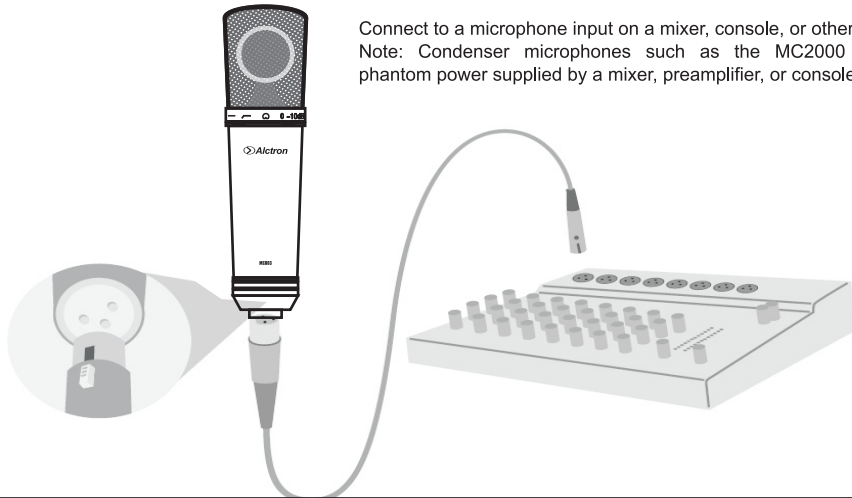

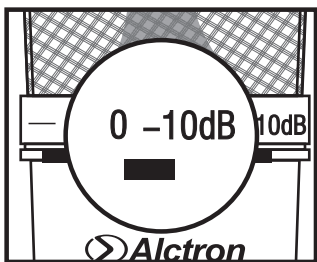
Attach to a microphone stand using the supplied shock mount.

4. XLR CONNECTION



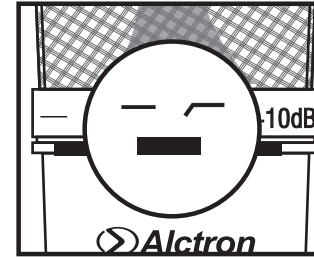

5. PAD SWITCH(MC003)



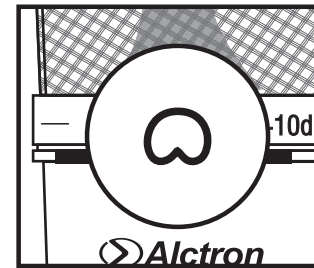
The pad switch helps prevent distortion from extremely loud sources, such as when close-miking horns or drums.

6. LOW FREQUENCY ROLLOFF (MC003)



The low frequency rolloff may be used for voice or medium- to high-range instruments. It reduces floor rumble and low-frequency room noise from heating and air conditioning systems. Also used to compensate for proximity effect or to reduce low frequencies that make an instrument sound dull or muddy.
